She was in an auto accident 23 years ago that caused her to have a mal union boot break which took two years to heal with continual complications, and recently was looking for a permanent resolution. After getting several medical opinions about how to improve her situation, she then spoke with Frieda Borth, attended the Round Rock Support Group, and took the opportunity to speak with many amputees and ask questions. She decided on a left BK amputation in August 2007. Kevin Kimbell has Susie in a BK suction socket with a one way expulsion valve. She wears a sleeve on the outside of her prosthesis for suspension. Susie is currently having PT sessions with Aaron Forman at OPT Austin, and one of her goals for next year is to play in the Texas Amputee Golf Tournament.
